- Replacement of brick lintels, replacement of brick, new sheathing and moisture barrier as shown on plans.

V. MBE Requirements: 10% goal

For Construction projects with a value of less than \$300,000.00:

Contractor to turn in with Bid a completed Identification of HUB Certified/ Minority Business Participation Form. MBE Appendix E to be turned in with Final Payment application.

MBE forms A, B, C, D, E are required to be turned in with the bids if bids exceed \$300,000.00. Minority Participation is encouraged.

- Owner has prepaid for removal of existing scaffolding. Contractor to assume rental costs during construction.
- All building exits to be maintained during construction Contractor to provide barricades/pedestrian safety devices as required.
- Painting requirements to be clarified in forthcoming Addendum.
- A sample brick wall will be required.
- Building Permits are to be obtained from the Town of Beaufort Contractor is responsible for obtaining and purchasing all required permits.
- Existing vertical supports for lintel to be painted with rust inhibiting paint.
- Please clarify what exterior items we are to pressure wash and paint....(Based on what the Owner will have painted outside of this contract)
- Detail 1/R-5... Please clarify that front and back side of masonry parapet wall must be removed in order for the new thru-wall flashing to be installed. Also, need clarification that Murray Roofing will be responsible for work in our contract, such as removal/replacement of the parapet coping/counterflashing, and any required membrane that wraps up the parapet wall and under the coping/wood blocking and can't strip at backside of parapet wall.
- General Contractor is responsible for repairing/replacing any concrete walks/pavement/asphalt pavement/landscaping areas/grassed areas.
- Please address the Base Bid duration and consider extending days from 150 to minimum of 175.
- Please address the additional time needed if either Alternate is accepted.
- Please provide Owner furnished map of proposed laydown area.
- Please address required locations for temporary construction fencing.
- Please clarify limitations of work periods, if any. Court date schedules/after 5 PM hour restrictions or weekend work restrictions, if any.
- Existing alum. Windows are field painted. Please address repaint requirements/responsibilities of GC.
- Please clarify that brick material Allowance of \$650/th does NOT include taxes/freight. Please address decision related to fluid applied waterproofing.
- Please clarify GC's responsibility of Builder's Risk coverage.... Only value of new work to be Insured.
- Please clarify sister stud gauge requirement.

- Reference Sheet R-5.....please clarify if Keynotes #8 and #12 (noted in all typical sections through the foundation) are typo, or need to be adjusted per General Keynote legend.
- Reference Spec Section 07600, page 2, Part 2.3/A..... Flashing at Decratile to match exiting tile color.... Is this a typo?
